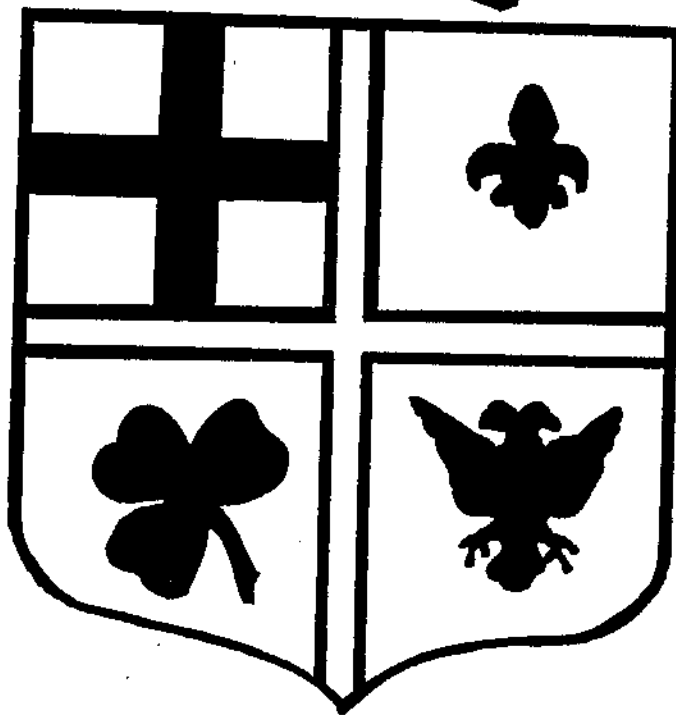

MARRIAGES, Early Massachusetts Prior to 1800, by Frederick W. Bailey, 661 pages, indexed.

This is the most complete collection of early Mass. marriages ever published containing over 20,000 entries for the period 1643-1800. The book is divided into four sections covering: Worcester County, Plymouth Co., Middlesex, Hampshire, Berkshire and Bristol counties; and Plymouth County again. This last section contains over 1,000 additional entries. Gives full name of the bride and groom and date and place of marriage.

INHABITANTS OF COLONIAL NEW YORK, Lists of, 351 pages, excerpted from THE DOCUMENTARY HISTORY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK by Edmund Bally O'Callaghan originally published in four volumes between 1849 and 1851.

This present work, prepared by Rosanne Conway, comprises all the genealogical records in the original and the index lists about 12,000 Dutch, English and German inhabitants. \$ 17.50

GENEALOGICAL DATA FROM COLONIAL NEW YORK NEWSPAPERS by Kenneth Scott, 278 pages, indexed.

In this volume of abstracts may be found information concerning marriage, birth, death, age, status, place of residence and of origin covering the years 1726 thru most of 1783 from four of New York's earliest newspapers. Other colonies mentioned are New Jersey, New England, Pennsylvania and Maryland. \$ 15.00

GENEALOGICAL DATA FROM COLONIAL NEW HAVEN NEWSPAPERS by Kenneth Scott and Rosanne Conway, 547 pages, indexed.

This abstract provides some 20,000 references to approx. 7,500 persons; such as list of unclaimed letters of New Haven, New London, Hartford and Norwalk. Also, news events such as murders, shipwrecks, fires and jail breaks; and advertisements on auctions, real estate, runaways and offers of goods or services. \$ 22.50

ANSON COUNTY, N.C., Abstracts of Early Records, by May Wilson McBee, 180 pages, indexed.

The abstracts are grouped as land grants, land grant surveys, deeds, county court minutes, civil suits, wills, probate reports and petitions; and separate sections devoted to Montgomery County and Richmond County records. Covers the period before 1790 when Anson County included all of western and central N.C. About 6,500 residents listed. \$ 12.50

NATCHE COURT RECORDS, THE, by May Wilson McBee, 1767-1805, 635 pages, indexed.

The Natchez District consisted of territory which now forms the Mississippi counties of Wilkinson, Adams, Jefferson, Claiborne and Warren, as well as Franklin and part of Amite. The inhabitants were mainly of British stock and this work refers to 10,000 persons. The first part covers the Spanish regime consisting of bonds, sureties, bills of sale for land and slaves, inventories, appraisals, wills, land transfers, mortgages, deeds, powers of attorney, complaints, petitions and court orders. The second part deals with British land grants. \$25.00.

GENEALOGIES OF THE FIRST SETTLERS OF THE ANCIENT COUNTY OF ALBANY, FROM 1630 to 1800, by Jonathan Pearson, 182 pages, indexed (1872) rep. 1978.

Early settlers to this New York county were Dutch, then English and Palatine Germans, Nearly 7,000 entries. Sources were baptism and marriage registers of the First Reformed Church, and county and city records of wills, deeds, mortgages, etc. \$ 12.00

GENEALOGIES OF HADLEY FAMILIES by Lucius M. Boltwood, 205 pip. indexed (1905) rep. 1979, Embracing the Early Settlers of the Towns of Hatfield, South Hadley, Amherst and Granby (Massachusetts). \$ 12.50

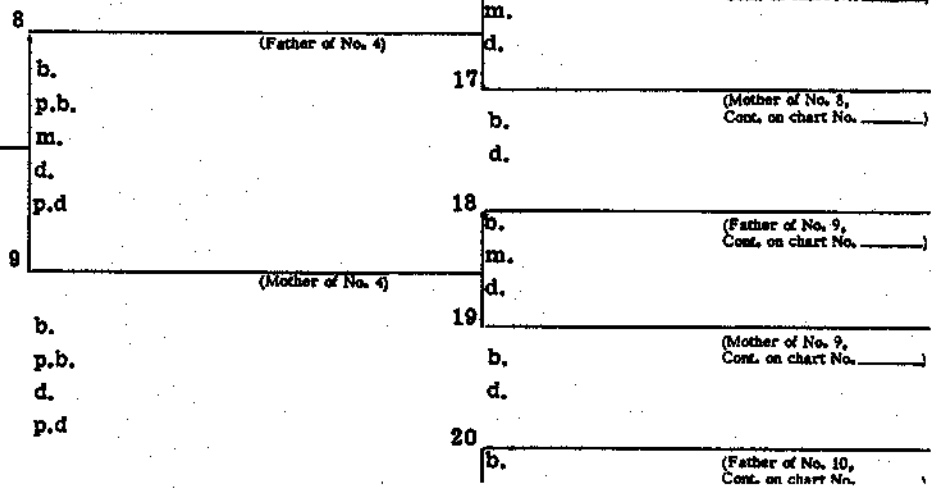
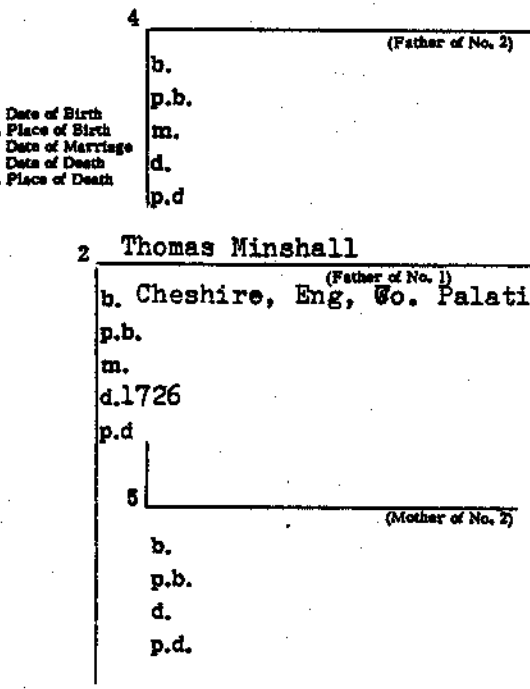

## Minshaw - Minshull - Minshall

John Minshall lived in County of Cheshire, England and had wife, Margaret and three sons, Thomas, John, Samuel, and four daughters, Mary, Elinor, Rebecca, and Elizabeth. His will is dated Sept. 6, 1683. This may or may not be the father of Thomas Minshall, who founded the American family.

Thomas Minshall, with his wife Margaret came from Parish Stoak, in County of Palatine, of Chester, (Cheshire) England in May, 1682. Previous to emigrating he secured on the 22nd of March, 1682 a grant of 625 acres of land in Penna.. This he received from William Penn, and afterwards a patent Deed from this illustrious proprietor for two more tracts of 725 acres. His first grant was the fortieth of the 1000 acres granted by Penn in his colony, By virtue of a warrant dated Sept. 9, 1682, there was surveyed to him in Nether Providence, Chester Co. a tract supposed to contain 300 acres. He also acquired other lands.

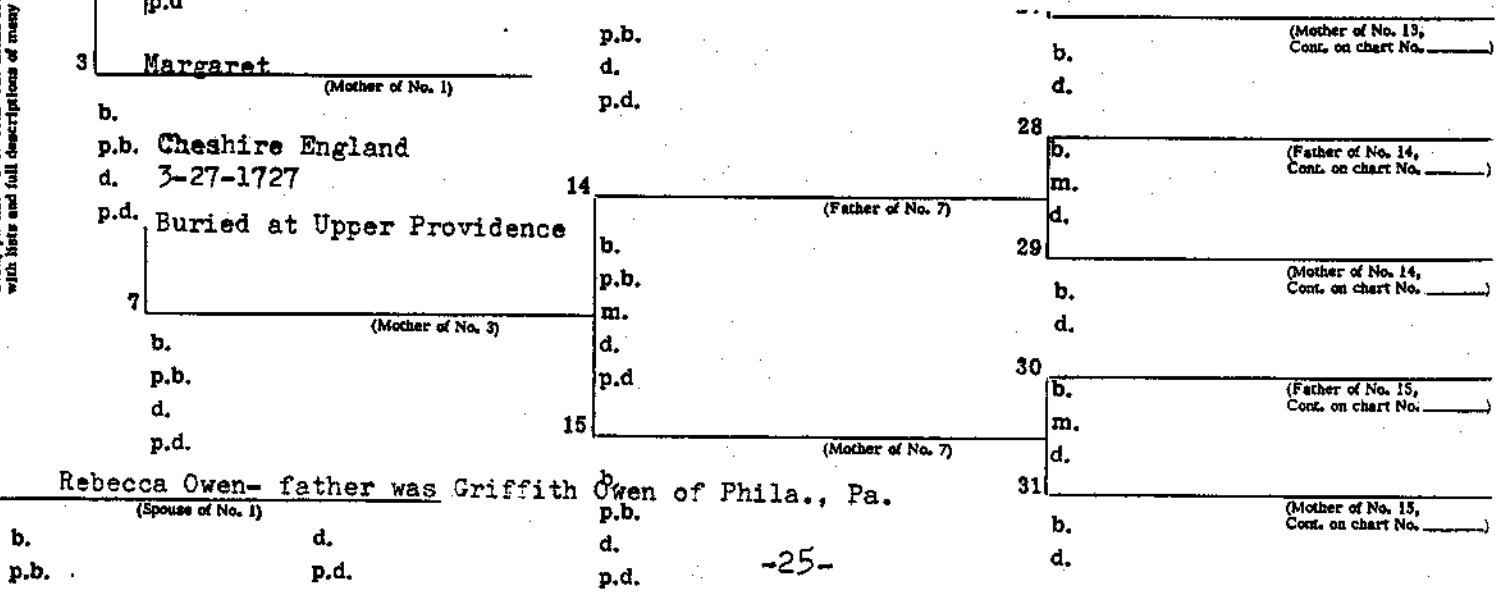
