

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COUNTY COURT - MARCH TERM - PROBATE

Taken from The Kankakee Gazette, March 25, 1875

Estate of Lewis A. Aldrich. Claims allowed: W. E. Scobey, \$16; L. E. Cunningham, \$1; C. Hacker Estate, \$94.65; Sutton, Carter & Co., \$4.50; A. E. Davis, \$68.65; Wm. Frith, \$35; F. C. Aldrich, \$25.35; Ripley & Chapman, \$2.25.

Estate of John Dugan. Sale bill approved.

Guardianship of Russel Baker. Guardian's Inventory approved.

Decree for sale of real estate entered against the estate of George T. Downing.

Zeno Streeter was appointed guardian of Wm. F. Streeter, minor.

Letters of administration were Issued to Ann Alden for the estate of Noah Alden.

Proofs made in the estate of Robert McElroy; application for approval of proof and discharge of executor continued until the further order of the court.

The bond of Josephine Brosseau In the sum of \$5,000 with Victor Brosseau and Noel Brosseau, sureties, as guardian of Joseph, Jacob and Mary Brosseau, minors, was approved.

The appointment of Albert Cowgill in vacation as administrator of the estate of Judith Mack, with bond of \$12,000, A. C. Cowgill, surety, was approved.

Decree entered for the sale of real estate in the estate of Lewis Kutemeyer.

Claims against the estate of Arcule Legris were allowed as follows: I. M. Thyfault, \$2; Joseph Lesage, \$3.35; Ell Bolsvert, \$11; Celestine Gravelin, \$38; Thomas Roy, \$15; P. Boudoin, \$35; Joseph Rivard, \$7; John Martin, appraiser, \$1.50; Demas Goslin, \$10; Moses Legris, \$116; Lewis Paquin, \$3.34; H. Senesac, \$1.50.

W. A. Hewett was appointed administrator of the estate of Mary M. Hewitt, in bonds of \$400, with B. F. Gray and Hans Green as sureties.

Proceedings in the estate of John Baum were continued.

Proofs were made in the matter of the conservatorship of Lucinda Sherwood. A verdict by Jury was rendered as to the idiocy of the defendant and B. F. Gray was appointed conservator upon filing a bond with Horace and John H. Sherwood as sureties.

Proofs were made and a decree for the sale of real estate was entered upon the petition of the guardian of Ellsworth Ellingwood, a minor.

The approval of the final report in the estate of Harriet Smith continued to next term.

Inventory of guardian of O'Brian heirs approved and petition to all real estate continued for service.

Marie Deslauriers, J. B. Deslauriers and J. E. Labrie appointed executors of the estate of Alfred Deslauriers, in bond of \$31,000. Appraisers were appointed.

The petition of B. F. Gray, administrator of the estate of Sarah Chatfield that the court order against the estate of Wm. A. Chatfield be paid, was continued to the 29th inst. by agreement.

The claim of the Continental Insurance company against the estate of Bela T. Clark was dismissed for want of prosecution. The administrator in this estate made final report and was discharged.

The claim of John Sanford of \$30, against the estate of Mary Smith was allowed. Administrator filed his final report, and notice for discharge was ordered published.

In the matter of the guardianship of Margaret Calahan et. al. vs. Bridges Dunn, Guardian, for citation to compel an account, the court ordered that report be filed by the first day of the next term.

Caroline A. Clark was appointed guardian of Frank D. Joy, a minor in bond of \$300.

In the estate of John T. Richardson the administrator filed his report, It was ordered the administrator be allowed to settle with the widow and heir! by purchasing outstanding notes of estate and taking their receipts therefor.

The petition of the guardian of Russel Baker to sell the ward's real estate was granted.

Inventory filed In the matter of the guardianship of the heirs of Wm. Hanan and proceedings continued to next term.

Ransome Greenman was appointed administrator of the estate of Rhoda Green of filing bond in \$150.

The inventory and report of the conservator of Lawrence Blackstone was approved.

The commissioners' report of assessment roll in the matter of the petition of Stravelowith and Dierking in the matter of a ditch was approved any ordered spread upon the records.

An order for the publication of final report was entered in the estate of James Bartlett.

The administrators' report in the estate of Henry Pfingston was approved.

James R. Bartlett was appointed guardian of Ann O'Mally, a minor, In the bond of \$500; proceedings in the petition of guardian to sell real estate was continued to next term.

The executor of Horatio P. Havens estate rendered an inventory of the additional personal property which had come to his hands after the death of the widow which was approved, and the report of the private sale of such property was also approved.

The inventory and appraisement bill in the estate of Elisha Havens was approved.

DECLARATIONS OF INTENT

Taken from the St. Louis G.S., Fall 1987

Many immigrants (but not all!) filed their Declarations of Intent at the port where they entered the U.S.A. Prior to 1890, this first step was completed on Castle Green Island and the records for this entry are at the Bayonne, NJ Federal Records Center. If the ancestor arrived before September 20, 1906, you have to check the court nearest to where he settled to find his final papers. If the ancestor was naturalized after 1906, the Immigration and Naturalization Service, 425 I Street NW, Washington, DC 20536, has an Index that may be of help in locating the court where the final papers were filed. After a statutory wait of about five years, immigrants completed the naturalization process (final papers) by getting affidavits of neighbors, taking an oath of allegiance and filing a final application. (Remember, not all immigrants filed for citizenship.)

New election ordered on the 13th of April, and that the ballots read "For Village Organization Under the General Law," or "Against Village Organization Under the General Law," and that Francis Seguin, Michael Rivard and Oliver Marcotte act as Judges of said election; notices ordered posted.

Estate of Peter Lebarge. Ordered that the sum of \$63.63 heretofore paid into court for the party entitled thereto being the distribution share of Martha Gerard as one of the heirs of Peter Lebarge, be paid over to Addison

Mann, it being found to the satisfaction of the court that he is entitled thereto as the assignee of said Martha Gerard. Final report approved, and administrator discharged.

Estate of Edmond Palmer. Final report approved and publication ordered; claims allowed: G. V. Huling, \$30; same, \$270.

Estate of Jonathan Rice. Executor's report approved.

Guardianship of Geo. W. Rice and Samuel W. Rice, minor heirs of Henry W. Rice. Humphrey Hopper cited to render report of his doings as guardian by first of next term.

Taken from The Kankakee Gazette April 22, 1875:

Report of Jonas H. Howe, guardian of Fanny Howland, a minor, filed and approved.

Letters of administration to W. H. Grinnell in the matter of the estate of Emerson Sammis; inventory and appraisal approved.

Claim of Celestin Gevlin of \$34.14 against the estate of James Crozier deceased allowed; final report filed and notice ordered published.

William Nichols and Peter Nichols appointed administrators of the estate of Wm. Nichols, deceased, estate of Wm. Nichols, deceased, bond with M. O. Clark and C. F. Wiltsie in \$10,000 approved.

Final report filed in the estate of Silas P. Garrett, deceased, and notice ordered published.

In the matter of the estate of Zeno Brayton. Report of H. Worcester, surviving partner of the firm of W. & B., and appraisal approved; agreement for sale of stock of goods approved.

Will of Jacob Neumann admitted to probate.

Final report of the administrator of the estate of Mary Smith approved and administrator discharged.

Guardianship of Ida, Herman and Edgar Smith, minors of Ira W. Smith, deceased. Guardian's report of final settlement with Ida Smith approved and she having attained her majority, guardian is discharged; guardian's report as to Herman and Edgar approved.

In the matter of the organization of the village of Bourbonnais, the official canvass of votes was approved. An election for six trustees ordered on the 11th of May; notices ordered and judges and clerk appointed.

Will of Frank R. Marcy admitted to probate; letters testamentary to Greenville Herring. Bond of \$10,000.

Inventory and report filed in the guardianship of Margaret Calahan et, al. vs. Bridget Dunn, guardian; continued to third day of next term.

Citation on Daniel and Jacob Hertz, administrators of the estate of John Hertz, deceased, returned served; on claim of Jacob Hertz the court appoints AMOS Hertz to defend.

The administrator of the estate of Emerson Sammis was given leave to sell property specified in the petition at private sale.

Will of Hiram S. Turner, deceased, admitted to probate, and Nancy Turner appointed administratrix In bond of \$700; appraisers appointed.

Inventory approved In the conservatorship of the estate of Lucinda Sherwood, and petition granted to sell real estate.

Decree for sale of real estate entered in the Guardianship of the O'Brien heirs.

In the matter of the guardianship of Ann Maria O'Malley, same order as above.

Final report of the estate of James Bartlett, deceased, approved, and administrator discharged.

Final report approved In the estate of Harriet Smith, deceased, and distribution ordered among the heirs.

Alexis C. Dandurand, guardian of Thomas and Mary Dandurand, ordered to show cause, by first day of next term, why he should not be reoved from office for failure to account and make settlement as required by law.

Guardian's report of sale In the guardianship of Ellsworth Ellingwood confirmed.

Victoria Reniche, administratrix of the estate of John B. Reniche, deceased ordered to make report by the first day of next term of the condition of the estate, and show cause for failing to discharge her duties as required by law.

Proofs for final settlement and discharge of administrator of the estate of Silas Garrett, deceased, made.

G. B. Joiner, John Durham and Joseph Rickey were appointed appraisers of the estate of D. F. Conan, deceased, inventory approved.

The claim of William Dodge of \$92.99, against the estate of Arcule Legris, allowed.

The administrator of the estate of W. A. Chatfield, deceased, filed his report.

Mrs. Rosella Coman was appointed guardian of the Coman heirs in bond of \$15,000 with sufficient surety.

Proofs of service on of Brosseau heir in petition to sell real estate.

In the estate of Judith Mack, inventory was approved, proofs of advertising for adjustment of claims; and claims of B. F. Uran, M.D., \$16 and Emory Cobb, \$917.25 allowed.

Claims of F. G. Gilbert for \$8.10 and Louis Salzman for \$20.70 allowed against the estate of L. A. Aldrich, deceased.

In the matter of the petition of Strodwith and Dirking, commissioners' report letting ditch was approved. Ordered that the amount of costs and expenses for the accomplishment of said proposed work be payable Immediately and that the same be a lien upon said land until paid.

Final report and discharge made of the administrator of the estate of James Crozier, deceased.

The judgment against the estate of Edmund Palmer, deceased, In favor of G. V. Huling for \$270 and entered at last term, being an error In computation, a new Judgment of \$300 is entered.

A jury was called on Tuesday to decide upon the sanity of Johanna Scheltung. A verdict of insanity was rendered, and the woman being in a delicate situation was temporarily committed to the care of the town poor master.

Ea enlisted in the Civil War as Charles Cadwright, Kankakee Musician, Company D, 65th Illinois Infantry (April 10, 1865, to July 13, 1665). He died in Chicago, Illinois, May 20, 1876. Pension to Mother, Louisa Cadrett, September 12, 1892.
