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HERITAGE QUEST ROAD SHOW

Presented July 26, 1988, at Asbury United Methodist Church.

For anyone who had an opportunity to attend this program and didn't, they missed out on a wonderful presentation. The following are some of the highlights of the program:

When starting in genealogy, it's important to <u>start with yourself.</u> Be sure to sit down and write all your memories of events which happened during your lifetime. Don't always start with your parents! It's a good idea to send out blank family group sheets to all your relatives requesting that they fill out and return them. Be sure to inquire about bibles, photographs, old letters, naturalization certificates, business papers, deeds, and family histories.

The largest collection of family histories are housed at the Library of Congress. If you write to them, they can tell you if there has been a history published on your family. It's always important to write for vital statistics and a great help is the "U.S. Vital Records Catalog" published by Ancestry.

Don't overlook the importance of funeral home records. There is a directory of funeral homes called "The Yellow Book" published by Nomis Publications, P.O. Box 5122, Youngstown, OH 44512. This directory includes all the hospitals and daily newspapers in the U.S. There are many funeral homes in your town which probably receive this directory yearly. Usually funeral home records are saved; and, even if the funeral home you're looking for is no longer in operation, the records have probably been saved by another funeral home in the area.

If you have located difficult to read tombstones, the following tools can be very helpful:

Shaving Cream (spray it across the top of the stone and take a flat edge stick and scrap the shaving cream all across the surface of the stone)

Wisk Broom

Water

Aluminum Foil

Whenever taking a picture of a stone, natural light is best. When using a flash, be sure to take the picture at an angle to avoid reflections.

There is a place where records are kept of the burial place for all soldiers:

Cemetery Service, National Cemetery System Veterans Administration, 810 Vermont Ave. N.W. Washington, DC 20422 "Newspapers on Microform" is put out by the Library of Congress and tells you what newspapers from what cities have been microfilmed.

Ft. Wayne Library is now the second largest genealogical library in the world. Their collection of county histories is considered one of the best. They encourage you to write and do research through the mail. Be sure to give specific name, date and place when writing. If nothing is found, there is no charge. If material is found, they will charge 20 cents a page plus \$3.00 per request letter. The average cost for inquires runs approximately \$5.00. Rare county or family histories will be copied at a cost of 15 cents per page plus a \$3.00 handling fee. The Ft. Wayne Library exchanges a large quantity of periodicals which they are in the process of indexing on a yearly basis.

Rules for Taking Notes:

- 1. Control the sheet size (be consistent 8 1/2 x 11 is best).
- Separate by surname (label each sheet with particular surname and don't mix family names.
- Separate by place of origin (state or country). This is how you subdivide the surname data base.
- 4. Give every page a sheet number.

Understanding a Pedigree Diagram:

A description was given for the Ahnentafel numbering system. Ahnentafel is German for "Forebearer Table". On your chart, males always appear in the upper position and have even numbers and females appear in the lower position and have odd numbers. If you want to find the number of an individual's father, double his number. If you want to find the number of an individual's mother, double his number and add 1.

When you have an individual who appears more than once, he only gets one number and every other listing should say "see # .

For siblings, you use .1 (first born), .2 (second born), etc., after the number of the ancestor. For further divisions, 6.4's wife would be 6.4s, and his children would by 6.41 (first born), 6.42 (second born), etc.

KANKAKEE COUNTY FACTS

On February 11, 1856, Kankakee County, formed from Iroquois and Will, was given its present boundaries except that two townships (30 and 21 north, 9

east), were added to the western part, February 14, 1885. The act creating Kankakee reduced Iroquois and Will to their present limits.

SCARCE OR RARE BOOKS

To find the location of a scarce or rare book, write National Union Catalog, Library of Congress, Washington, DC 20408. Give date of publication and publisher, if you know them. If they can locate a copy in the Library of Congress or in any one of many of the larger libraries throughout the county, they will respond with several locations. You then have the option of trying for an inter-library loan of the book, or asking for a microfilm or photocopy from one of the libraries.

SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Taken from the Genealogy Society of Southern Illinois, Vol. 16, No. 11.

Social Security Administration Applications shown the address of the applicant, date and place of birth, father's name and mother's maiden name. One needs Form F SSA-L997, from any S.S.A. office to obtain a copy of the application form for a deceased relative for Social Security.

The S.S.A. plans to destroy the original 37 million applications for Social Security. They have computerized some of the information, but much of the general information has been omitted. This information will be lost when the original forms are destroyed. The early files include many persons born in

the 1860's and 1870's, and many naturalized citizens. It is suggested that letters be written to the Social Security Admin, 6401 Security Blvd., Baltimore, MD, 21235, and to your representatives in Congress for assistance to retain these valuable records.
