GERMAN RESEARCH

The society received a letter from Hans Joachim Hinners, Wurster Strasse 390 b, W-2850 Bremerhaven-Weddewarden, Germany, stating he does research work in the northern region of Germany, especially in the area around Bremerhaven, extending as far as Cuxhaven, Stade and Bremen. Since this area is very near the coast and the main migration ports of Germany, he feels he has access to many valuable records. In the past 10 years he has collected information from churchbooks and works in the Courthouse as a secretary. He has churchbooks for the following Years: 1715-1726, 1746, 1751, 1752, 1759-1852.

Mr. Hinners charges \$10/hour plus mileage and postage. Also, he has available an Ortssippenbuch (village lineage book) for the village of Misselwarden. The volume is 334 pages and covers 1680-1900. It is available at a cost of \$40 cost including postage (surface mail) is \$40. Air mail is \$10 extra. He has asked that only cash be sent as the German banks extract a large service fee for handling foreign checks.

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


